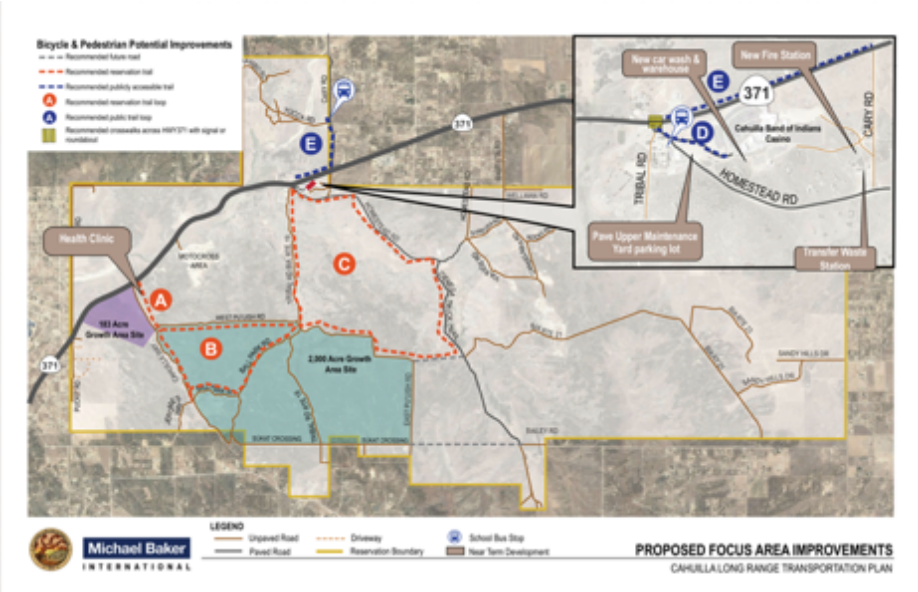

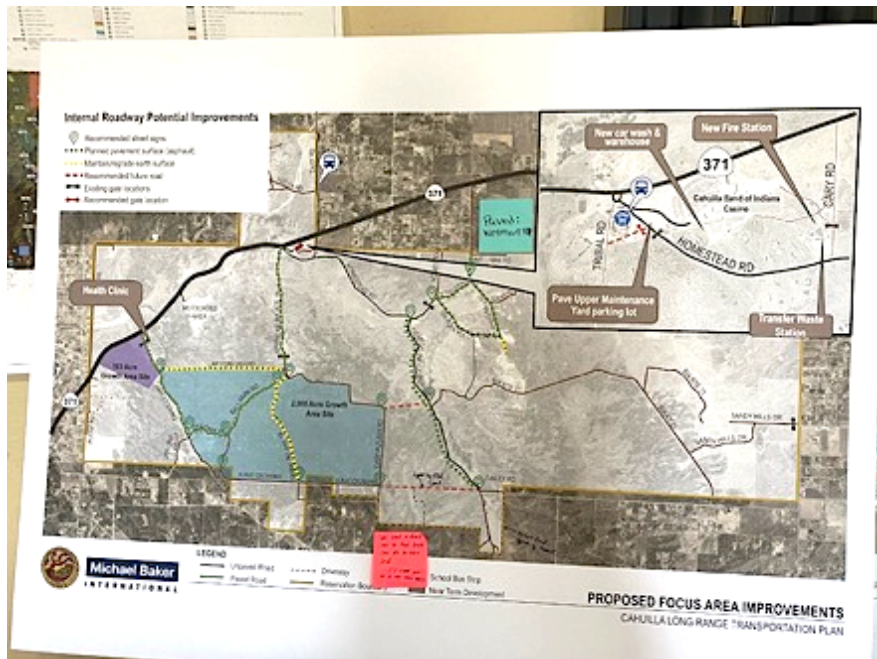

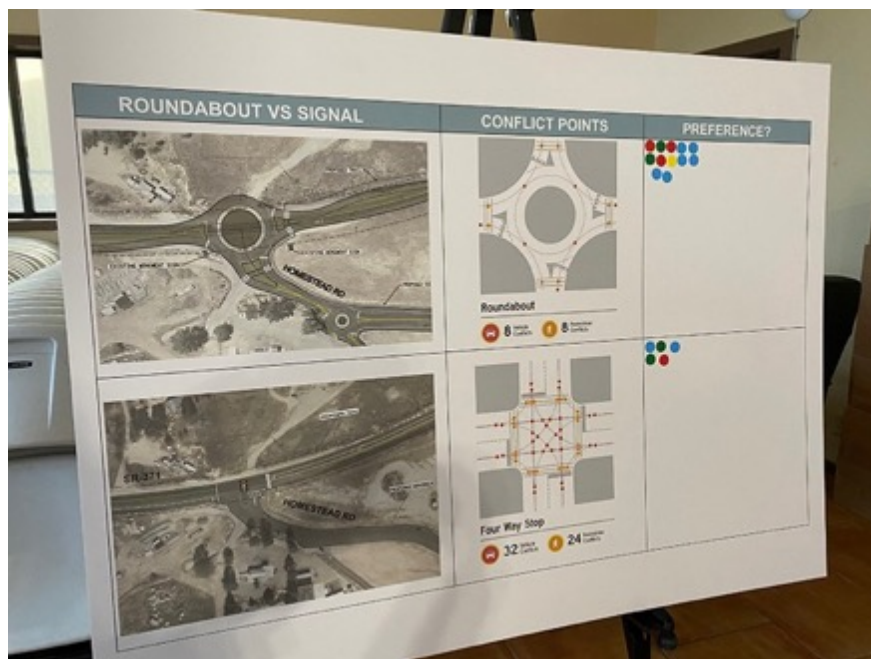
- a. Paved: Wellman Road

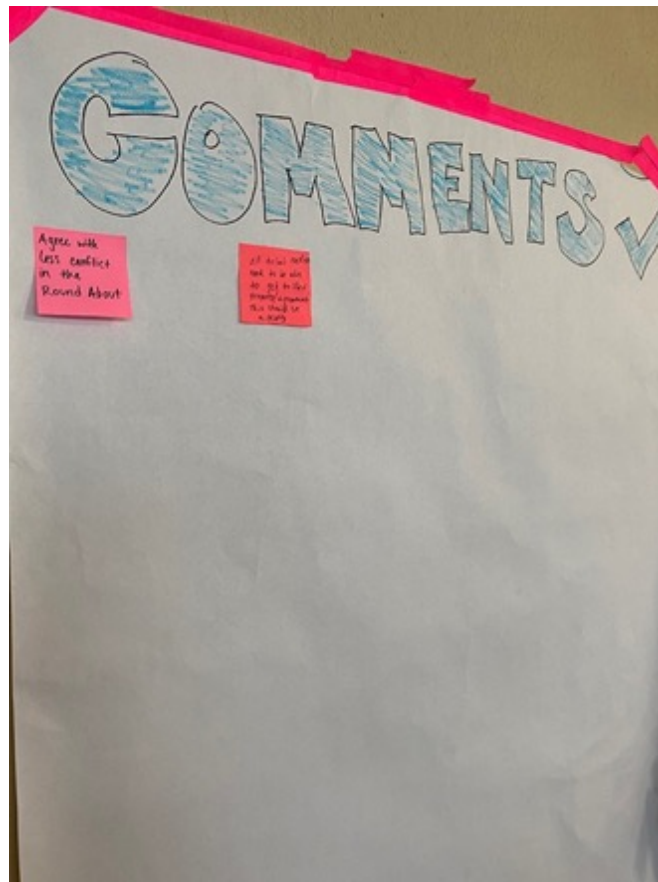

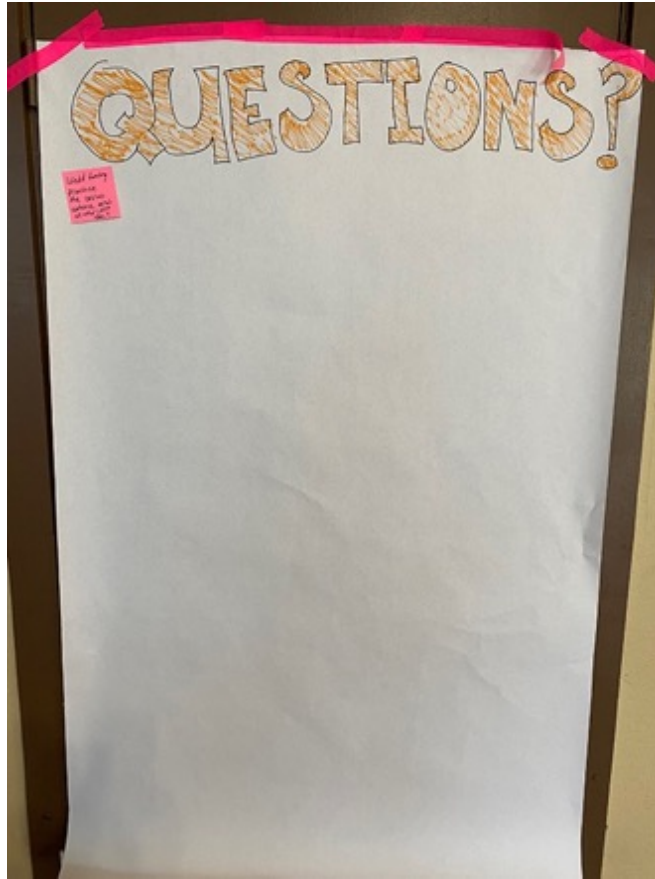
